The biggest surprise of the



# Partygoer Shows Signs of Social Disorder, Yes

"But I continued to talk about psychology because it's very fascinating and I know so much about it. Also, when it comes to people with Asperger's, routine is important. Routine is important. That's what I learned in psychology class. Yes."

The promising young psychiatrist went on to explain that he has had an interest in the human mind ever since his mom started taking him to "psychology classes" every day after elementary school.

"I got to see firsthand what psychologists do on a day-to-day basis, and the people taking notes always seemed happy when I was able to accurately identify people's emotions in the pictures they showed me," he said. "But Psych classes are MUCH harder now."




Grossman choosing to take a shit in the corner where it's just mostly Phil Collins albums.

After returning to the Forty, Welt reportedly did a really good job of being a nice friend and sharing the alcohol with all his little buddies.



Acknowledging the bizarre nature of his claim, Pistorius admittedly remains uncertain as to how he could have tragically mistaken his girlfriend for a burglar.


"I'll never know," he said. "I'm stumped."




